




Can Lluc: Ambassador of Sustainable Tourism

Ibiza Preservation

We collaborate with the Ibiza Preservation foundation in the protection of the native lizards Podarcis pityusensis that are in danger of extinction due to the invasion of horseshoe snakes coming from root balls or trunks of ornamental olive trees. Ibizan lizards, besides being a unique species and a cultural icon, have a pollinating function that contributes to the island's agriculture.
