INTRODUCTION

Opened in 2003, Can Lluç is a world-class farm stay in Ibiza and one of the first ten farm stays to be established on the island. In the heart of the island, this 10-hectare estate is barely 10 minutes away from Ibiza and San Antonio and sits in a peaceful valley with a great ecological and scenic value, surrounded by woods of pine, carob, fruit and ancient olive trees as well as a vineyard with 2000 vines. A true haven where you will live an authentic experience that brings together nature, local identity and luxury.

At Can Lluç, tradition and modern comforts coexist in harmony in the common areas and in the spaces devoted to accommodation. This luxury farm stay has 25 rooms, 7 of them decorated in a rustic-chic style are in the centuries-old house, while the other 18 suites and villas are styled following the modern Ibizan architecture and surrounded by gardens. There are also another two traditional-style holiday homes: Can Jaume Curt (5 people) and Can Prats (4 people).

Constantly upgraded and adapted to the latest trends and technologies, Can Lluç works hard every day to align with the sustainability standards of the Spanish Comprehensive Scheme for Tourism Quality at Destinations (SICTED) and the Circularity Plan, among other standards. This commitment extends to the entire property, where the hotel is involved in protecting the Ibiza wall lizard (*Podarcis pityusensis*), a seriously endangered species native of Ibiza and Formentera, to support the actions led across the island by the non-profit organisation Ibiza Preservation.

HISTORY

In 2000, the Ibizan couple formed by the economist Tina Soriano and the lawyer Lucas Prats decided to venture into an exciting project alongside the architect José Torres. Through this project they turned a country house –built over 200 years ago and owned by Lucas’s grandfather, José Prats Costa–, into a boutique farm stay in the heart of Ibiza, where tradition, nature and hospitality co-exist in harmony.

Lucas and Tina’s love for Ibiza’s landscapes, traditional architecture and cultural heritage, together with their vision to create a different accommodation for those who seek authenticity, peace and nature, are the cornerstones of Can Lluç, one of the first farm stays in Ibiza and Formentera. Opened in 2003, the establishment has never stopped developing, improving its facilities and services whilst keeping its essence.

“The project began with the refurbishment of the ancient country house, called a payesa house, where Lucas spent a large part of his childhood. The renovations took three years, being extremely careful to preserve the characteristic elements of the Ibizan architecture, like stone walls and wooden beams and bringing together traditional and modern elements under the same roof”.

A great deal of Can Lluç’s authenticity lies in its décor, where restored farming equipment and tools take us back to the estate’s past and its farming origins, giving character to the common areas.

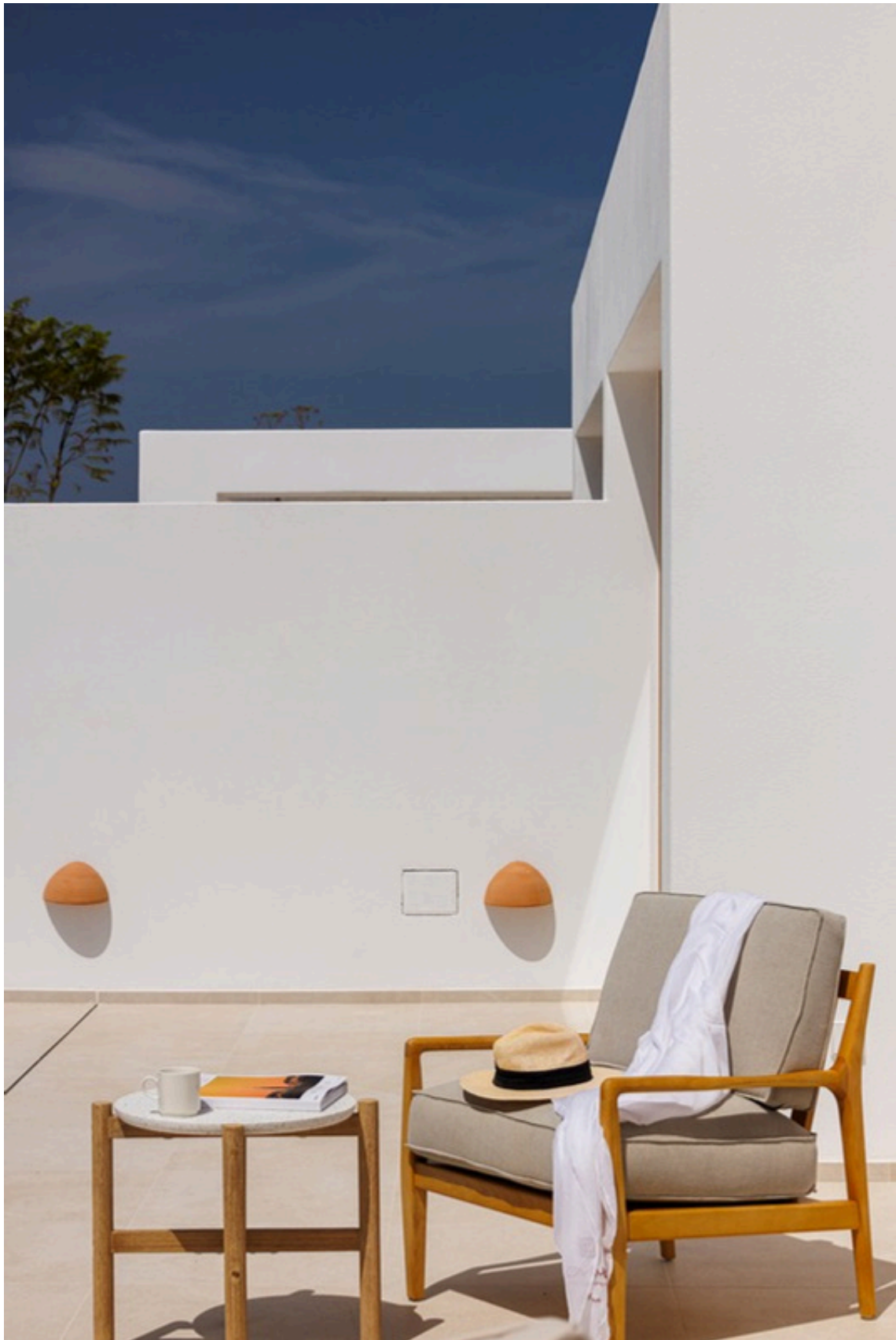
The olive trees, fig trees, lemon trees and other fruit trees surrounding the estate evoke that past, but also its present. Nowadays, the property continues to be farmed with great care, keeping its vocation as productive land. Indeed, it produces its very own extra virgin olive oil that is part of the hotel’s food proposal, based on fresh local produce, some of it grown on Can Lluç’s estate.

Together with the farm land, nature is an essential part of the Can Lluç experience. Across its over 10 hectares of land, formed by gardens, paths and pine-tree woods, the estate preserves spots that strengthen its bond to rural Ibiza, like old restored buildings, outdoor areas suitable for rest and viewpoints to admire scenic views and the sunset on the western coast.

Over the years, Can Lluç has progressed to adapt to new travel styles without losing its essence, shifting from a pioneering farm stay to a country boutique hotel. The original proposal has gradually grown with new types of accommodation, from rural rooms to private villas, suites and options for those who appreciate more space, privacy and comfort. One of those expansions is in the form of the Premium Garden Suites for guests seeking more space, privacy and comfort. It's especially suitable for long-stay couples and families with kids.

Today, what started as a dream has turned into a third-generation family project that continues to grow in harmony with the Ibizan character, landscape and authenticity of country life.





ARCHITECTURE

ARCHITECTURAL EVOLUTION

Can Lluç is a payesa house, an old country house built in the heart of the island of Ibiza before the 19th century. Almond, olive, fig and carob trees grow in its gardens, spread over the terraces made with ancient dry stone walls which have always brought order to the land and integrate the estate nicely into the landscape.

The architectural action was based on a key premise: respect the existing vernacular architecture and allow the estate to evolve without losing its soul. The old chicken coops, barns, offices and the farmhouse are now all under the same roof, keeping the traditional Ibizan elements and engaging with them through modern language. Stone walls, flat roofs, porches, joinery and a carefully balanced ratio between full and empty articulate a project where traditional and modern elements coexist naturally. This is how our **Rural Rooms** came to life.

This set of rooms features a modern-style pool, where water takes on a unique role, running down a narrow channel to spill into the main body of water, reminiscent of the Arab architecture that is present in the island's water heritage. This dialogue between legacy and new elements, between the modern expression and Mediterranean roots, continues to define Can Lluç's architectural character.

Later on came the new architectural pieces that expanded the project without disturbing the balance.

“The Villas marked the turning point for the country hospitality sector in Ibiza: these were far more than rooms, they were a new way of inhabiting the landscape. The owners chose something that was completely new on the island: suites in the countryside, among almond trees, designed with clean lines, large openings and a smooth transition between indoors and outdoors. Spaces where light stretches the architecture, the landscape invades every spot and privacy becomes a serene luxury”.

The **Events Hall** came to life as a natural extension of this evolution. Next to the hotel's main entrance but on a lower level, this room was conceived as a discreet piece, integrated into the topography and separated by plants and ancient stone terraces. Its architecture, with clear geometrics and flexible vocation, introduces a more modern and open language for meetings, celebrations and gatherings without sacrificing coexistence with the immediate landscape. Modern, light and versatile features at the service of premises that continue to dialogue with the estate's olive and carob trees and ancient walls.

In 2017, **Can Prats** emerged as a newly built villa to meet the need for family accommodation. Its architecture is a tribute to the traditional Ibizan homes through a modern-day lens: handmade terracotta tiles, joinery, white walls, flat roofs, south-facing porch, gentle edges and minimum outdoor intervention, intentionally avoiding eroding the land and altering the surrounding trees. This villa features a serene, essential architecture that is closely connected to its surroundings.

Accommodations for 21st-century travelers

Later on, the Premium Garden Suites were built to tend to travellers' new sensitivity, with a growing love for large, open spaces, privacy and a more generous interaction with nature. Its construction at the top of the land means guests can enjoy a deeper sense of quiet and openness along with a strong sense of being in a modern haven surrounded by nature. Architecturally, they expand Can Lluç's language: clean volumes, smooth indoor-outdoor transitions, private terraces and gardens and an atmosphere where comfort is expressed through simplicity and light.

The most recent development comes in the form of the **Deluxe Suite Villas** with private pool, a couple of two-bedroom units on the hillside of the lush pine-tree woods that go by the name of Atalaia de Sant Rafel. From here, the architecture opens up to a 270° scenic view of gentle hills from east to west, across the terraces of the estate and stretching out to the sunset and the faraway outline of sa Talaia de Sant Josep, the highest spot on the island. In these villas, privacy, space and landscape take on a new dimension: the building settles naturally on the land and contemplation becomes an essential part of the experience.

This is how Can Lluç has moved from the 19th century into the 21st century without compromising its consistency. Its architecture does not indulge in nostalgia but rather in live continuity: preserving the essence, incorporating the new with respect and allowing each extension to keep telling the same story, the story of an authentic, bright Ibiza that is deeply bound to its landscape.

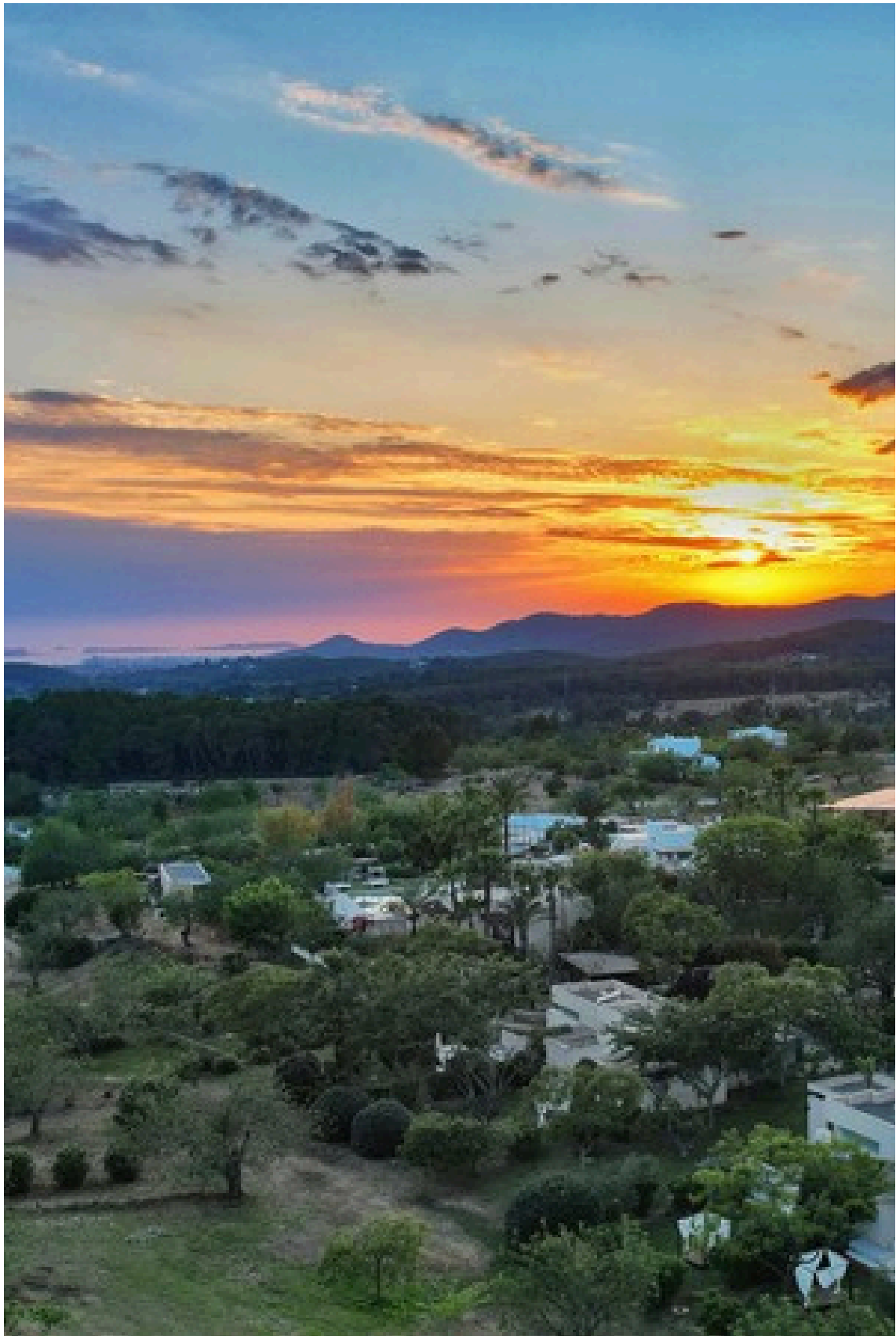
ABOUT JOSÉ TORRES

José Torres (Pep Torres) is an Ibiza-born architect who specialises in residential, hotel and landscape integration projects on the island. Having graduated from ETSA university in Barcelona, his over 30 years' career has earned him the position as President of the Official Professional Association of Architects of the Balearic Islands for Ibiza and Formentera for two terms and his works are known for their dialogue between traditional architecture and modern language.

His projects have featured in Spanish and international architecture, design and lifestyle magazines, including National Geographic, Elle, Wallpaper, Arquitectura y Diseño, Nuevo Estilo, La Vanguardia and Vogue. His actions at Can Lluç were based on the balance between Ibizan vernacular architecture and a modern frame that is deeply connected to the landscape.

SETTING

Can Lluç sits in a peaceful valley with great ecological value in the heart of the island. It's surrounded by woods with pine, carob, fig, fruit and ancient olive trees as well as a vineyard with 2000 vines. The hotel is only 2.8km away from San Rafael, the only village on the island declared an "Area of Craft Interest"; 9.7km from the city of Ibiza; and 9km from San Antonio and its bay. Its ideal location is one of the most appreciated aspects by guests, as it allows them to explore Ibiza easily while also enjoying the peace, privacy and quiet of the countryside.

The 10-hectare estate stretches across the mountainside of the Atalaya de Sant Rafel, facing the area traditionally called Coll d'en Lluç. There's a track along the estate that leads to a lookout with scenic views of Sa Talaia de Sant Josep, the highest mountain on the island (475m), Portmany bay, Conillera island and, north-west, part of the Es Amunts mountains, a Special Protection Area. On this trail there is also an old lime kiln and an old stone beehive, a sample of Ibiza's traditional beehives.

"Some of the most remarkable sites near Can Lluç are the Forada market, selling local traditionally-made products (Saturday mornings), the Bibo Park, which is the only biotechnological botanical garden in Europe, the Aloe Vera Museum called Ibizaloe, and the village of San Rafael, in the geographical centre of the island, acting as crossroads for some of the main roads in Ibiza".

This small village preserves the essence of Ibiza's inland villages and is known for its traditional bars and restaurants, its local atmosphere and its historical connection to pottery –increasingly scarce on the island. It is also known for its fortified church, built in the late 18th century in the traditional style of Ibiza. This church stands at the entrance to the village, on a square with a stunning view of the city of Ibiza and the sea.

Another place of interest close to Can Lluç is the valley of Es Broll de Buscastell, one of the most characterful areas in the countryside. Here you will find fantastic trails to explore this valley that preserves the old Andalusian irrigation system, with ditches and narrow channels that still make up a beautiful, authentic picture of farmland.

Given its location in the heart of Ibiza, Can Lluç is also the perfect base to explore the entire island. Guests can also reach the most famous beaches and coves on the southern and western coasts, visit Santa Eulalia and its villages or explore quieter spots in the north. Near the hotel, there are also excellent restaurants serving traditional dishes or the latest food trends.

ROOMS

Can Lluç's accommodation is divided into two groups that reflect both sides of today's Ibiza: Rural Rooms and newly built Suites and Villas. Both types of rooms have air conditioning, heating, mini bar, smart TV, satellite TV channels, hair-dryer, phone and WiFi.

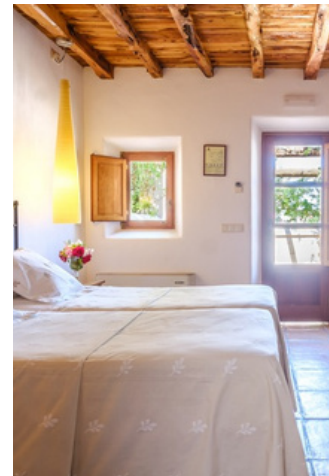
Rural Rooms

In an old family house, these 7 rooms, decorated in a tastefully rustic style are perfect for guests who want to immerse in Ibiza's history and tradition. They have been named in honour of the different elements that made up country houses on the island: S'Aljub (water cistern), Es Carro (cart), Es Güelo (grandfather), Sa Mula (mule), Ses Garroves (carob), Es Paier (barn) and S'Era (era).

Deluxe with terrace (5)

Sleeps: 2 people

This 30m² private space includes a bedroom, bathroom and private terrace overlooking the gardens and/or pool. There is also a unit adapted to persons with reduced mobility.



Superior with living room (2)

Sleeps: 2 adults + 2 children

More than 40m² of private space with bedroom with king-sized bed (180 cm x 200 cm), bathroom, living room with fireplace and a sofa with truckle bed. It also boasts a large terrace with direct access to the gardens and a view of the countryside.



Superior with jacuzzi (2)

Sleeps: 2 adults

This 40m² private space has a bedroom, bathroom with a large double hot tub and a south-facing balcony-terrace with a spectacular view of the countryside.

SUITES & VILLAS

This type of accommodation consists of 18 suites and villas surrounded by gardens between the terraces on the estate. These are perfect for guests who seek wider spaces, privacy and comfort in a modern setting that blends into the Ibizan landscape.

Family Suite (2)

Sleeps: 2 adults + 2 children

This 60m² private space is especially suitable for families as the suite includes a bedroom with a king-sized bed (200 x 200cm), bathroom with rain shower, living room with a sofa bed, a kitchenette and a large terrace. The bedroom and living room can be separated by a sliding door. Even better, it also boasts a private garden with outdoor shower and a Balinese bed.

1-bedroom Villa (6)

Sleeps: 2 adults + 2 children

This 60m² private space has been designed to maximise privacy as the villa is surrounded by wonderful gardens. It has a bedroom with a king-sized bed (200 x 200cm), bathroom with rain shower, living room with sofa bed, kitchenette, outdoor shower looking out onto the garden, a pergola over a furnished terrace and a private garden with sun loungers and a fountain.



Premium Garden Suite (8)

Sleeps: 2 adults + 2 children

This 70m² private space combines privacy, wide spaces and a modern style. It has a bedroom with a king-sized bed (200x200cm), bathroom with rain shower, living room with sofa bed, a dressing room, patio with outdoor shower and a large furnished terrace with pergola and a scenic view of the gardens and countryside.



Deluxe Suite-Villa with pool (2)

Sleeps: 4 people

This 180m² private space has two connected bedrooms, making it perfect for families, as well as a bathroom, hot tub, patio with outdoor shower, kitchen, large terraces, private pool surrounded by gardens and a scenic view of Ibiza's countryside.

FOOD

Can Lluç's food brings to the table the same philosophy that defines the hotel: authenticity, land and respect for the island's natural pace. Its restaurant proposes Mediterranean cuisine with Ibiza roots based on local products, recipes tied to the local culinary history in a modern frame that highlights taste, seasonality and well-understood simplicity.

At the helm of the kitchens is Marga Prats, one of the best-known ambassadors of the Balearic cuisine and a firm advocate of the island's traditional recipes. The origins of her cuisine lie in her family legacy and the everyday teachings by her grandmother, mother and father, a master of rice dishes, and it is expressed through a cooking style that is deeply connected to Ibiza's in-season produce. Rather than reinterpreting tradition, Marga preserves, fine-tunes and shares it through the lens of today's sensitivity without losing its essential truth.

Marga Prats took part in the Peix Sí! recipe book promoted by the regional government, Consell d'Eivissa, and the fishing guilds. This highlights her role as an advocate and ambassador of the Balearic Islands' cuisine. Her career brings to Can Lluç's restaurant a specially valuable dimension for those who wish to become acquainted with Ibiza food from an authentic, modern perspective rooted in the land.



The restaurant menu upholds some of the most recognisable flavours of the island's gastronomy, including dishes like the Ibizan fish paella, black rice with cuttlefish, payesa salad, savoury cocas, which are a sort of flatbread topped with in-season ingredients or other combinations born from the island's family culinary imagination. As for her sweet creations, she includes specialities like the *fláó*, *greixonera* and *orelletes* in the menu to tighten the bond with tradition.

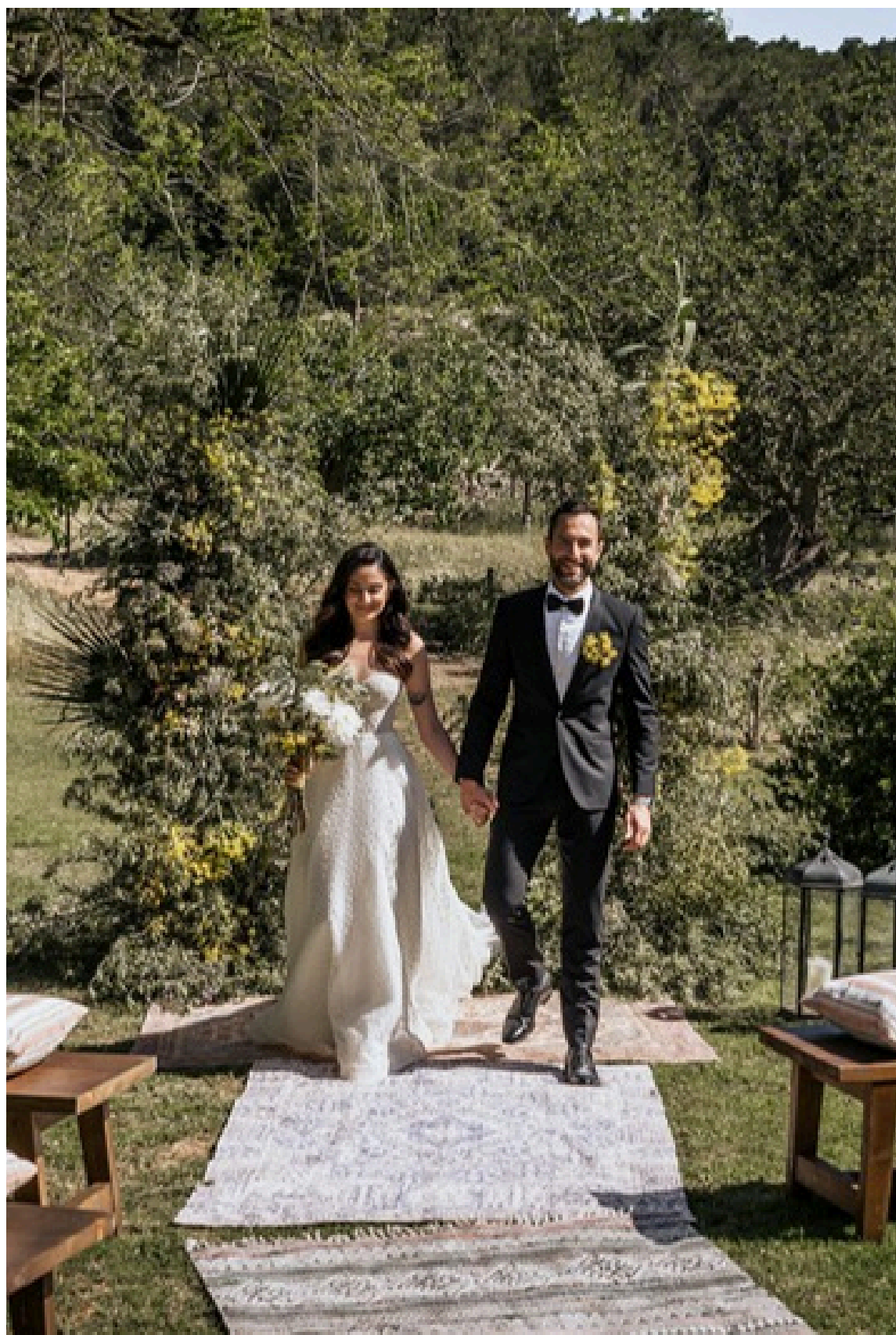
Can Lluç's food also finds a natural continuity on the estate. The homemade extra virgin olive oil, along with fruit and produce from the estate is part of a proposal that connects the landscape to the table and turns the food experience into another way of discovering rural Ibiza.

BREAKFAST

Breakfast at Can Lluç is part of this same narrative intertwining produce, land and attention to detail. The proposal combines local makes and homemade products together with a balanced selection of sweet and savoury options to provide, first thing in the morning, the simple tastes of the island: fresh in-season fruit, sourdough bread made by the Can Bufí bakery, Can Lluç's own extra virgin olive oil, homemade jams, freshly ground coffee (Cafés Ibiza), Ibizan cold meats from Companatge, freshly made omelette and traditional cakes.

In the heart of the island, among gardens, terraces, olive trees and Mediterranean woods, this luxury farm stay has all the pieces required to host boutique retreats for small to medium groups, for specialised organisers or for private groups seeking a more private and personal experience.

Its nature as an Ibizan country estate alongside its accommodation facilities, means the group can enjoy accommodation, practice, rest, food and wellness under the same roof. These services and facilities help make every retreat a success and add to the versatility of its spaces, as Can Lluç boasts large outdoor areas surrounded by nature, great for yoga and meditation, as well as an equipped room, gardens, gazebo, rooftop above the restaurant and other spots on the estate that fit in nicely with the pace and style of each retreat.

The proposal is completed with a wellness-centred offer that includes yoga lessons, massages, treatments, sauna, pool and gym. Aside from all this, our food is based on fresh, in-season local produce that can be adapted to the needs of each group, including healthy, vegetarian or other specific diets for wellness programmes.

Can Lluç allows you to create your retreat as a several-day experience where yoga sessions can be accompanied by walks, rest, Mediterranean food and landscape-gazing. In this regard, the estate is aligned with a modern way of understanding wellness: more linked to the setting, the human scale and the idea of a serene, understated luxury.

SUSTAINABILITY

Ibiza's traditional architecture and farming practices were known for their respectful and sustainable use of the land and its resources. Can Lluç's legacy is protected thinking of future generations through a sustainability policy that fuses comforts with our commitment to the environment.

Thanks to this action and awareness, Can Lluç has the international Green Key ecolabel and the Spanish SICTED certificate, which certifies the sustainable tourism quality of the services provided at the premises. Also, the hotel is a member of the top-standard list of sustainable accommodations called Beyond Group of the Preferred Travel Group.

Details of Can Lluç's sustainability

- 30% of its yearly consumption comes from renewable energy.
- "Agua Km 0" (zero-kilometre water) system that eliminates plastic bottles.
- Zero Plastic Policy on all the premises: getting rid of single-use plastic containers and giving priority to recyclable and biodegradable materials.
- Organic bathroom toiletries (made with natural ingredients and sustainable containers).
- Conservation of native species and protection of the woods.
- Bioclimatic architecture that respects the original structure of the estate and makes the most of natural light.

Sustainable food
